SCHEDULE NOTES

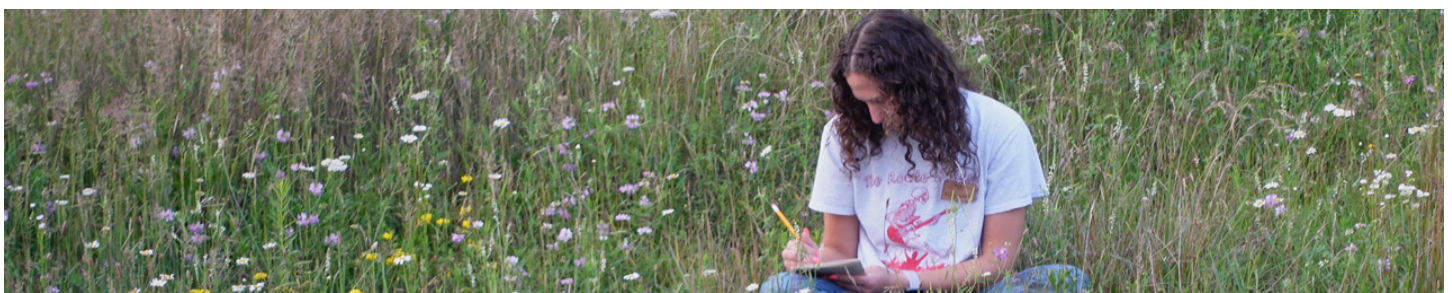
